Mission

Cascade Unitarian Universalist Fellowship congregation, members and supporters live out the values of the Unitarian Universalist faith.

Purpose

The purpose of the Congregational Life Team is to promote fellowship and events that support the values and connection of the fellowship.

Membership

The Congregational Life Team has an Ad-Hoc membership of 30-35 CUUF members/supporters. Staff support is provided by the office staff.

Commitment

Membership on the Congregational Life Team has no specific term of service. All members seek to support, in a voluntary, shared, non-hierarchical structure that assists the congregational life activities of the Fellowship.

Process

The Congregational Life Team identifies activities that would be of interest to the congregation and sets dates. Prior to the event, the coordinator sends out an email detailing the assistance needed for the event. Team participation in those activities is voluntary.

Responsibilities

- Identify congregational activities and set a calendar – some examples are Congregational Dinners and Acoustic Cafes.
- The Team Chair seeks volunteers for each aspect of the event. Team members volunteer and assist with the event.
- Promotes activities and opportunities through the CUUF communication network

Reporting and Review

There is no formal, scheduled reporting or review of the activities outside of the team itself.
